Puppet Show “Keeling” Task

If you did not complete the puppet show, or if you got a failing grade on the puppet show, the only way to make up the points is by doing the following EXACTLY as prescribed:

Complete the puppet show as it was originally assigned (see assignment sheet at webstacplecourse.com)

AND

Write a fifteen-page screenplay (see sample script at webstacplecourse.com) focused on a life-changing event. That means write a 15-minute movie about a significant event in *your* life.

In order to complete the minimum page requirement, you may not use font larger than 12-pt and you may not fudge the margins. Instead explore details in the narration, have fun with a variety of characters and use multiple settings.

Both scripts MUST be typed, in 12.pt font and with margins no larger than one inch.

Odyssey Essay “Keeling” Task

If you did not turn in an *Odyssey* essay, you must complete that essay as it was originally assigned (see assignment sheet at webstacplecourse.com)

AND

Write an additional essay about the following poem, analyzing the central theme and author’s use of literary devices.

“Hope” by Emily Dickenson

Hope is the thing with feathers
That perches in the soul,
And sings the tune without the words,
And never stops at all,

And sweetest in the gale is heard;
And sore must be the storm
That could abash the little bird
That kept so many warm.

I've heard it in the chilliest land
And on the strangest sea;
Yet, never, in extremity,
It asked a crumb of me.

Both essays MUST be original (not plagiarized), typed and in MLA format.
